

## Using the Computer with the Projector



1. First, press the **ON** button to power the unit. The **WAIT** button will blink for 30 seconds before you can use it again.
2. Next, turn the computer and monitor on. The computer tower is located in the bottom of the lab cabinet. All the cables you need are already plugged in.
3. Then, follow the instructions above on how to power the projector.
4. Finally, once the **WAIT** button has stopped blinking, press the button on the keypad labeled **COMPUTER**. The same image on the computer's monitor will now be displayed by the projector as well.
5. **When you are finished with your session, be sure to press the OFF button on the keypad to turn the projector off.**

## Connecting Your Laptop to the Projector

1. Before turning your laptop on, connect the provided VGA, audio, and Ethernet connectors (shown right in picture) to your laptop.

**Note: For Mac laptops, you will need to provide your own VGA to DVI/mini DVI adapter. Such adapters may be purchased from [apple.com](http://apple.com).**

2. Next, press the **ON** button to power the unit. The **WAIT** button will blink for 30 seconds before you can use it again.
3. Then, press the **LAPTOP** button on the keypad once the **WAIT** button stops blinking.
4. Some laptops require you to press the **FN**, or function key in conjunction with the F7 or F8 keys to project your image.
5. **When you are finished, power off your laptop before removing the cables. Finally, press the OFF button on the keypad to end your session.**

**Note: Use the volume buttons on the keypad in conjunction with the laptop volume controls in order to get the desired volume.**



## Using Video with the Projector



1. First, turn on the video device which is located in the bottom of the podium.
2. Then, press the **ON** button to power the unit. The **WAIT** button will blink for 30 seconds before you can use it again.
3. After this, press the button labeled **VIDEO** on the keypad.

**Note:** *You may use the VOL UP, VOL DN, PLAY and STOP buttons on the keypad to control the video device.*

4. When you are done with your session, shut off the video device located in the podium. Then, press the **OFF** button on the keypad to power down the projector.
